



LEGEND

SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS INUNDATED BY 100-YEAR FLOOD

- ZONE A** No base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AE** Base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AH** Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually areas of ponding); base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AO** Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually sheet flow on sloping terrain); average depths determined; for areas of elevated flooding, velocities are determined.
- ZONE A99** To be protected from 100-year flood by Federal flood protection system under construction; no base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE V** Coastal flood with velocity hazard (wave action); no base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE VE** Coastal flood with velocity hazard (wave action); base flood elevations determined.

- ZONE X** Areas of 500-year flood; areas of 100-year flood with average depths of less than 1 foot in most drainage areas less than 1 square mile; and areas protected by levees from 100-year flood.

- ZONE D** Areas in which flood hazards are undetermined.

NOTES

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources of small size, or all structures, features within Special Flood Hazard Areas. The community map repository should be consulted for more detailed data on RM7, and for any information on boundary determinations, prior to use of this map for property purchase or construction purposes.

Areas of Special Flood Hazard (100-year flood) include Zones A, AE, AH, AO, AV, VE, V, X, and Y.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by flood control structures.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydrologic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Refer to floodway data table where floodway width is shown as 100 feet.

Corporate limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user should consult appropriate community officials to determine if corporate limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.

This map may incorporate appropriate boundaries of Coastal Boundaries Insurance System, 1985 and/or of Other Protected Areas established under the Coastal Barrier Improvement Act of 1990 (P.L. 101-591).
